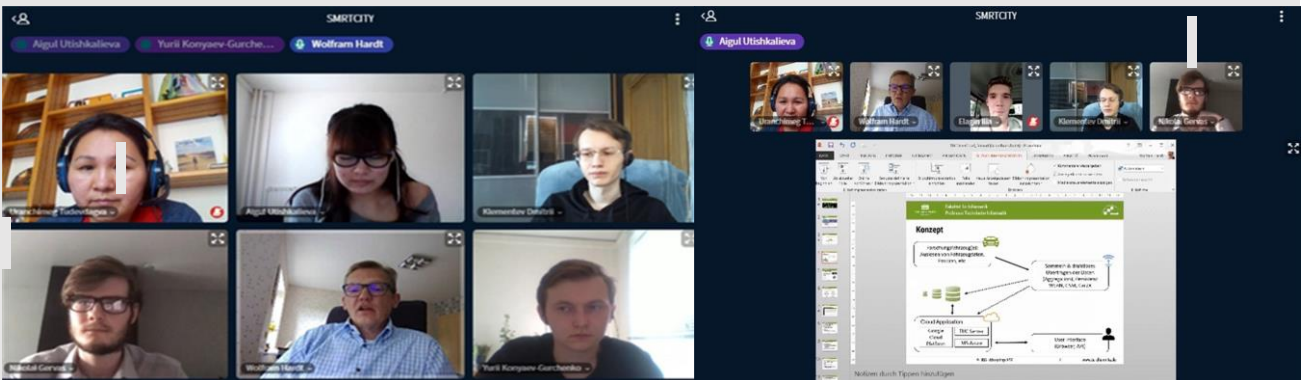


Figure 1. Virtual meeting with SSTU and NSTU students

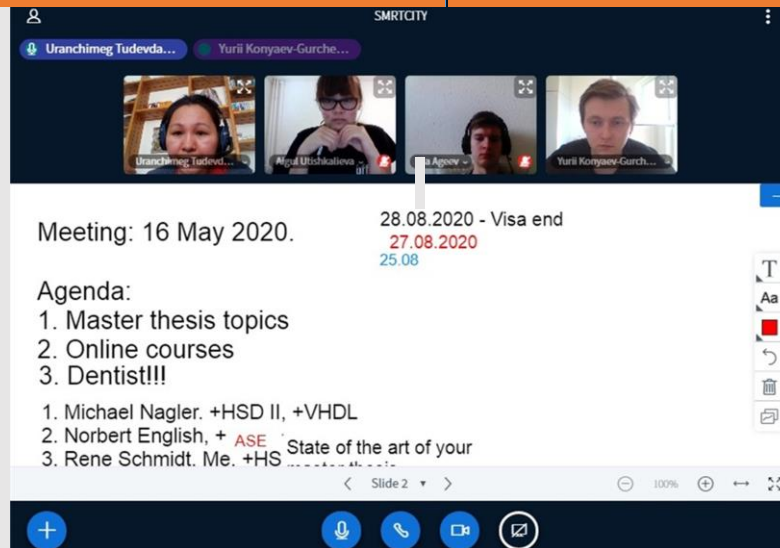
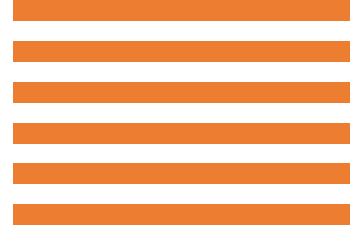


Figure 3. Discussion on selected courses and exams with SSTU students

- ✦ Virtual meetings by online about NSTU students master thesis;

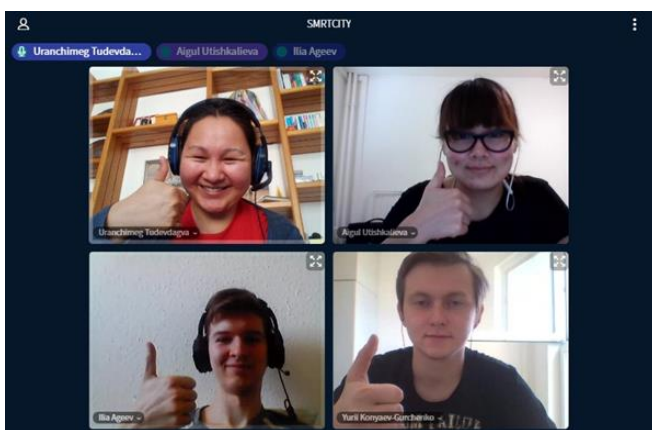


Figure 4. SMRTCITY students happy to be in Germany

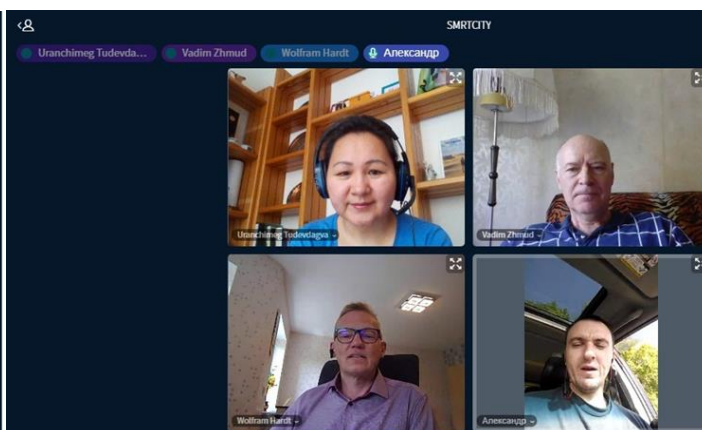


Figure 5. Discussion NSTU and CUT

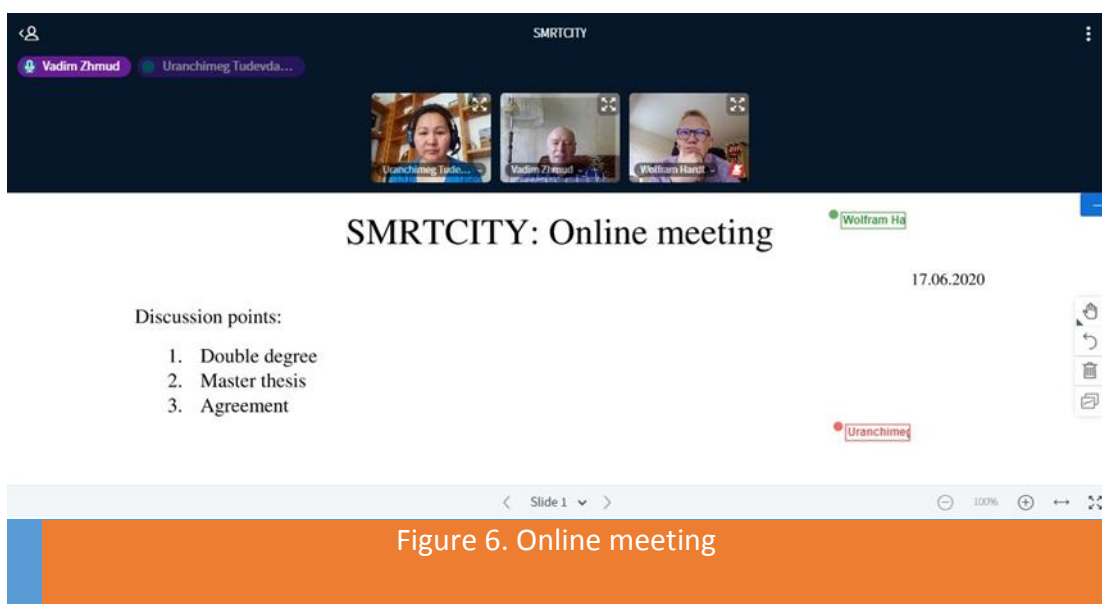


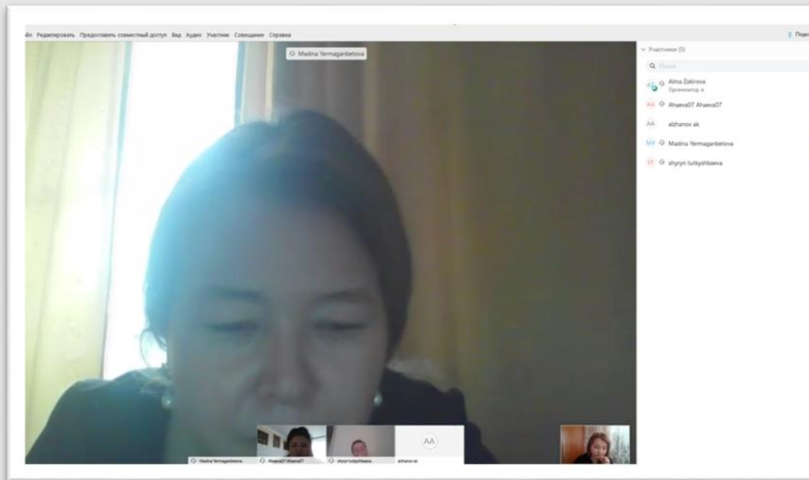
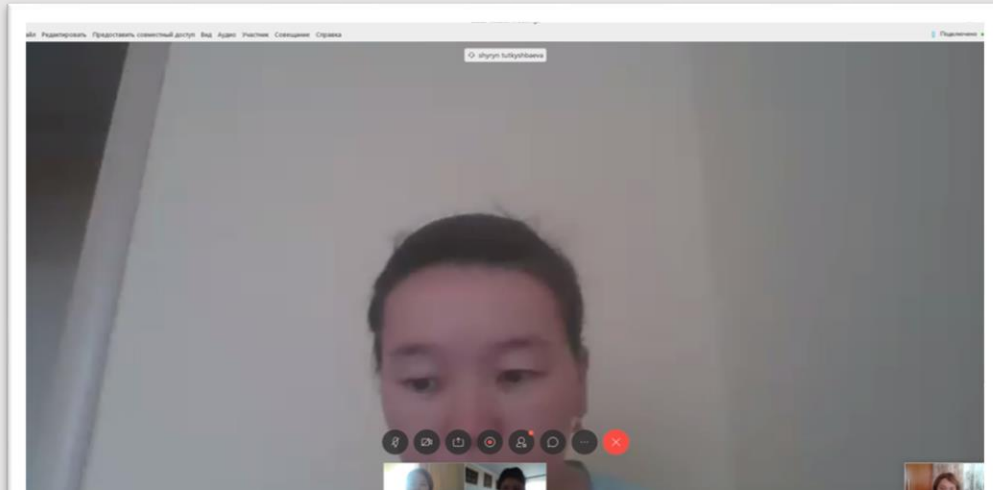
Figure 6. Online meeting

On May 30, 2020, an online meeting was held with the project participants. The results of the work performed were summed up and the work plan for next year was announced.

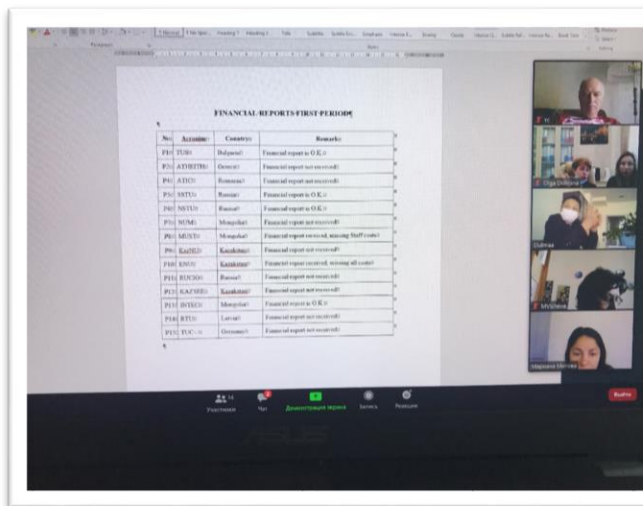
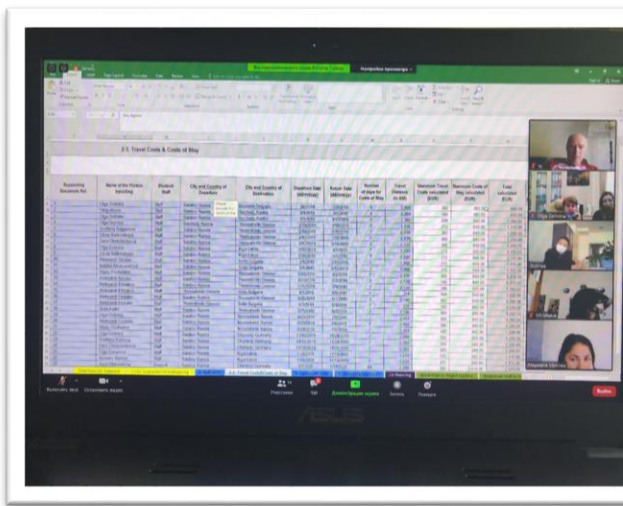
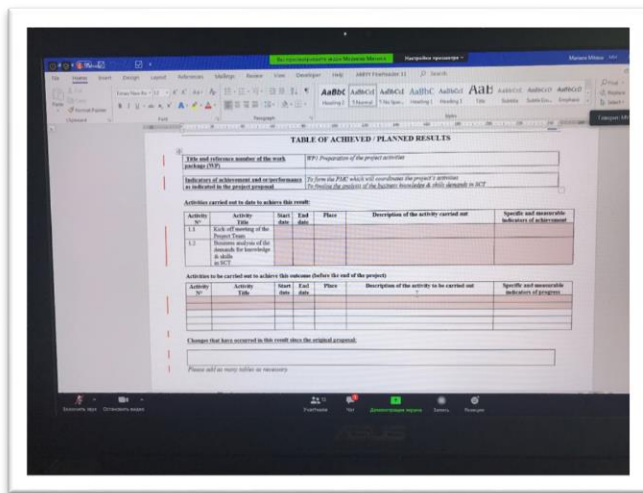
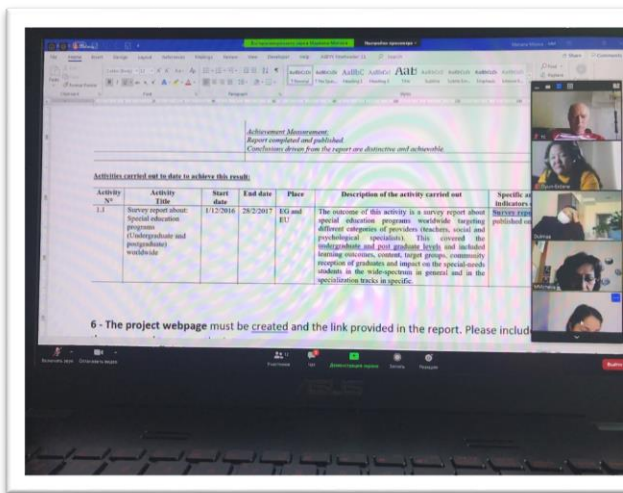
